

PUBLICATION OF NOTICE BY THE HON'BLE EX-CHIEF JUSTICE JYOTIRMAY BHATTACHARYA, CHAIRMAN-CUM-SPECIAL OFFICER (ELECTION — 2022) POST NOMINATION AND DECLARATION OF 3 (THREE) TRUSTEES OF THE NEW BOARD OF TRUSTEES

In terms of the order dated 10th March 2022 passed by His Lordship the Hon'ble Justice Shekhar B. Saraf in IA NO.GA/30/2021 in CS/308/1872 (Balaram Das -Vs - Guru Charan Biswas), the Chairman-cum-Special Officer published a notice dated 18th March 2022 inviting suggestions for new Rules and Guidelines, from the shebaitis, for election to be held in the year 2022.

After receiving and considering such suggestions, the Chairman-cum-Special Officer framed a fresh set of Rules and Guidelines which were published on the website www.dakshineswarkalitemple.org on 8th April 2022. The claims for shebaity right and/or extent of shares of shebaitis were determined by the Chairman-cum-Special Officer on 24th April 2022. Inclusion of new shebaitis with their respective share position/alterd share position in shebaity right was published on the website.

As previously announced the last date for filing nominations for the post of 3 (three) members of the new Board of Trustees was 26th April 2022 till 6 p.m. Only 3 (three) nomination papers were received till such date and time for the said post of 3 (three) Trustees. The said nominations were from -

- 1) Kusal Chowdhury,
- 2) Samarendranath Sarkar, and
- 3) Ashok Das.

The nomination papers were checked and found to be all in accordance with the Rules and Guidelines. Upon scrutiny of the same by the Chairman-cum-Special Officer the nomination papers were found to be in order and none of the above nominations were withdrawn within 6 p.m. on 28th April 2022.

Since only 3 (three) nominations have been received for the post of 3 (three) members of the new Board of Trustees, there is no scope and/or necessity for voting by ballot or through postal ballot. Accordingly, the voting scheduled on 22nd May 2022 at the Dakshineswar Kali Temple premises will be unnecessary and is not required to be held as notified earlier.


Therefore,

- 1) Kusal Chowdhury,
- 2) Samarendranath Sarkar, and
- 3) Ashok Das, the only 3 (three) persons from whom valid nominations were received are declared to be successful and will stand elected without any contest for the post of 3 (three) Trustees of the new Board of Trustees and will be announced after necessary order is passed by the Hon'ble Court.

The Chairman-cum-Special Officer will place a report accordingly before the Hon'ble Court.
